These are the praises that I've been waiting for. This is the Hosanna that I want you to sing – the Hosanna that opens your heart. For you see, the word hosanna means "to be open, to be wide, to be free, to be safe."

You're calling for me to be willing to defend those that need to be defended, you're calling me to come into the place for those to be avenged who need to be avenged.
